Live Webinar Oral Contracts Relating to Land

It is well known that land contracts have to be evidenced in writing. However, when land is leased or disposed of in the name of trust, love, or friendship, parties frequently do not have a written contract; their contract may not even be complete. In the commercial context, this may also happen as a “handshake” agreement. This talk examines the circumstances which such “contracts” may still be enforceable. This talk also examines the developing doctrines of part performance, proprietary estoppel, and common intention constructive trust in the Hong Kong context. Typical cases and key practice points will be considered.
